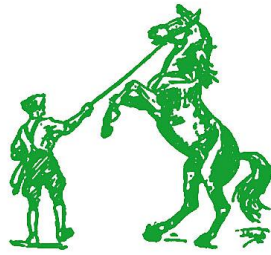

## ENTRIES TO ARRIVE BY FRIDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> MAY 2021

Entries must be made via Entrymaster



### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The show is run in accordance with the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain Rules for 2021.
2. No responsibility will be accepted by the Organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors and/or Riders or their Horses. Entries are accepted on this basis.
3. Classes will not run ahead of schedule, but large entries might cause some classes to over-run.
4. Entries must be received before the day and no entries on the day to reduce numbers in the Show Office.
5. There is a maximum of 3 people per pony/horse who are not subject to social distancing. A Parent/Guardian must attend the Show to accompany any child under 18 year of age.
6. No members of the public to be admitted to the showground.
7. Lorries and cars to be parked with adequate distance in accordance with social distancing guidelines as indicated by the parking attendants.
8. **People with any symptoms of Covid-19 must under no circumstances enter the showground.**
9. Horses and ponies **do not** need to be registered with any society or have a height certificate.

#### 10. RIHS QUALIFIERS:

Classes **19 – 24 & 44** are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The First Prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Entry Fee = £25.00 (includes of £10.00 RIHS Levy).

Only horses registered with SHB (GB) and who are also registered on the current year's Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter in Qualifying Classes for Ridden and Working Hunter Championships and the Show Hunter Registration Number must be quoted on all entry forms. Any horse that is entered for a Qualifying Class without first being on the Show Hunter Register cannot subsequently be registered and therefore will not be eligible for entry in any qualifying classes for the remainder of the season. Competitors may compete on a day ticket and may have a maximum of two Day Tickets per season. Each day ticket is valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/over-stamp for that show. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/over-stamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

#### 11. NOVICE CLASSES:

Novice classes **1 - 4, 9, 12, 15, 18, 26, 30, 33 & 37** inclusive. Horses which have not won a first prize of £60 or more, or more than a total of £200, including Championship Prize Money, in any showing classes at home or abroad, prior to the 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a four-year-old are excepted unless that four year old has won an Open ridden class. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.

#### 12. SHOW PONY CLASSES:

- 12.2HH SHOW PONY, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th. birthday before 1st. January in the current year.
- 13.2HH SHOW PONY, Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 128cms. but not exceeding 138cms. suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th. birthday before 1st. January in the current year.
- 14.2HH SHOW PONY, Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 138cms. but not exceeding 148cms. suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th. birthday before 1st. January in the current year.

#### 13. SHOW HUNTER PONY CLASSES:

- 12.0HH SHOW HUNTER PONY, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 13.0hh SHOW HUNTER PONY, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms. and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- 14.0hh SHOW HUNTER PONY, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms. and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- 15.0hh SHOW HUNTER PONY. Mare or Gelding, 4 y old and over, exceeding 143cms. and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

#### 14. INTERMEDIATE CLASSES:

- INTERMEDIATE CLASSES. Open to horses and ponies, 4yrs old or over exceeding 146cms, but not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

15. The Organisers reserve the right to make alterations to the published timetable, cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend the conditions of any class at their absolute discretion. If entries are large it may be necessary to arrange preliminary judging.

#### 16. REFUND OF ENTRIES:

**REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN UNLESS A VETERINARY OR DOCTORS CERTIFICATE IS PRODUCED. ALL REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE OFFICE WITHIN 7 WORKING DAYS AFTER THE SHOW. ALL CERTIFICATES/PAPERWORK MUST BE RECEIVED WITHIN 14 WORKING DAYS AFTER THE SHOW. PLEASE NOTE A £15 ADMINISTRATION FEE WILL BE RETAINED BY THE SHOW FOR ADMINISTRATON PURPOSES.**

There will be no refunds for clashes or missed classes.

#### 17. STABLING:

No overnight stabling is available, due to Covid-19 regulations.

#### 18. DOPE TESTING:

Please note all Horses on the Showground may be required to be dope tested and testing will be via blood or urine samples.

#### 19. DOGS:

Dogs must be kept on **leads at all times** and are only allowed in the car and lorry parks. Dogs are not allowed in the competition or public areas, main building or cafeteria.

#### 20. COMPLAINTS:

Any objection or complaint must be made in writing and signed (no anonymous complaints will be actioned) and submitted to the Disciplinary Steward or Secretary on the day of the Incident.

## Class Timings

Times are shown as a guide only but the Show will NOT run ahead of schedule.  
If large entries cause classes to over-run there will be no refunds for clashes.

GRADE YOUR MARE**

**BENEFITS OF MARE GRADING**

- 1) The top three mares will receive a voucher valued at £400, £300 & £300, which can be redeemed on the registration of a foal by an SHB(GB) Graded Stallion. Valid for 3 years. The award will be determined by the grading marks achieved throughout the year. The Robert Warden Memorial Trophy will be awarded annually to the owner of the mare that receives the highest marks.
- 2) Apart from the mares receiving the top mare awards, all mares achieving Head Stud Book status will be awarded a voucher for a free foal registration (including DNA). Vouchers are valid for two years, to be used on any SHB(GB) Graded Stallion currently registered for the year of covering.
- 3) Recognition with The World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses.
- 4) Entry into one of the SHB(GB) Stud Books and thereby progeny eligible for Stud Book papers. The progeny must be by an SHB(GB) Graded or Approved Stallion or the sire must be registered as a breeding stallion with another official breed society. The progeny of SHB(GB) Graded Mares by unregistered stallions will not be eligible for the Stud Book.
- 5) All progeny eligible to compete in the BS age classes.

**TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR MARE GRADING MARES MUST:**

- 1) Be 148cm or above.
- 2) Be 3 years old or over.
- 3) Submit a sample for a DNA test for which the owner is liable for the cost (£60) once accepted into any of the Stud Books, unless a profile is already available for the mare.
- 4) Be registered with SHB(GB), or be in possession of a Passport issued by another DEFRA-approved P.I.O. Only breeding recorded on the passport will be accepted.
- 5) Be owned by a current member of the SHB(GB).

- If you are bringing more than one mare please return & remain with your lorry between mares.
- Please provide your own refreshments and be aware that toilet facilities will NOT be available.
- Social distancing must be observed at all times and we strongly advise the wearing of face masks for all exhibitors, helpers and officials.
- Exhibitors must leave the venue immediately once their mare's grading is completed.
- All rosettes and mark sheets will be forwarded by the office following the grading.  
Assessors are requested to provide their own clip boards and pens.
